

DYNAMIS ACADEMY SUMMER CAMP COVID-19 PROTOCOL



We are following strict guidelines from CDC and the Virginia Department of Health to maintain a healthy environment to protect campers, parents, and staff. Camp administrator and staff have been properly trained on all safety protocol. Parents please note we are implementing the following strategies to enhance camp safety:

- Thermal temperature screening for staff and campers upon entering.
- Staff or campers with a fever of 100.4 or exhibiting other COVID-19 symptoms will not be allowed in the facility.
- ✓ Visitors are not permitted during camp hours.
- Staggered arrival and drop-off so that only one family is in the lobby at once.
- ✓ Following Governor Northam's recent Executive Order regarding facial coverings children and staff in child care or camps are NOT required to wear masks. However, family members who enter the facility for pickup or drop-off must wear masks.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer stations are placed throughout the facility. Campers must use hand sanitizer upon entering camp. Staff will supervise hand washing throughout the day.
- ✔ Parents must send in a towel or yoga mat (labeled with child's name) to use for social distancing activities (quiet reading, movie time, meditation). Parents are responsible for daily cleaning of mat or towel.
- ✓ Sharing toys and electronic devices are prohibited. Please do not send in any toys with your child that cannot be properly disinfected. Electronic devices are only allowed on Thursdays unless your child needs their device to complete summertime schoolwork.
- Lunch and snack time will be staggered to maintain social distancing.
- Staff will follow strict schedule for increased, routine cleaning and disinfection multiple times throughout the day (including wiping down frequently touched surfaces such as door knobs, light switches, table and countertops, bathroom sink handles and counter, kicking bags, and balls).
- Summer camp will be primarily in-house, however, daily outdoor activities are included as well as weekly trips to local parks. The Dynamis Academy bus will be properly disinfected after each trip and hand sanitizer will be used after leaving playground area.
- ✓ Please keep your child home if s/he is sick. If a camper gets sick during the day, s/he will be isolated and sent home.
- ✓ If a child or staff member tests positive for COVID-19 they are required to notify the camp administrator immediately. The camp administrator will then contact each parent and local health officials.
